Shoes in ANY condition accepted. Even ones in bad shape can be taken apart and the parts used. Lakehurst West resident, Mary Koglin, will pick up at your home and deliver to the Soles4Souls warehouse. Used shoes create sustainable jobs and funds which directly benefit relief efforts, including distribution of new shoes.

The average person in North America throws away 70 pounds of textiles every year. That's 21 billion pounds of extra waste dumped in our landfills every year! And the EPA estimates only 15% is donated or recycled. Since 2006, Soles4Souls has diverted 71 million pounds of shoes and clothing from landfills.

Most of us can't fathom what it would be like to lack something as basic as a pair of shoes, but for millions of people around the world, that's an everyday reality. Soles4Souls partners with women's shelters, veterans' organizations, children's programs and schools to get shoes and clothing to those who need it most.

Shoes are a resource that individuals who live in extremely poor countries can use to start a small business. Your shoe donations mean a constant supply of quality product. This ensures these fledgling businesses can be sustained long-term.
